COURSE FRAMEWORK

Scope:

The Upgraded Bridge Team Management course meets the recommendatory requirements for knowledge, understanding and proficiency in Section B-VIII/2 of the STCW 95 Code and as required by U.S. CFR 33 (157.415) It puts emphasis on the Procedures for Navigational Watch keeping and Bridge Team Management described in KLSMS Manual G-03.

Objectives:

After completion of the course, the trainee will be

- More competent and aware of their navigational watch keeping responsibilities.
- Able to help bridge team members interact and support, the master and/or the pilot in a positive manner.
- Able to effectively apply the principles in safe navigational watch keeping through bridge teamwork procedures
- Able to carefully assess various navigational watch-keeping situations and act positively as part of the Bridge Watch keeping Team.

Entry Standards:

This Course is intended for Licensed Deck Officers in charge of a navigational watch. Endorsed trainees should be fully conversant with Collision Regulations, preferably with ECDIS, AIS, Radar Plotting and Radar Simulator Training Certificate.

Course Certificate:

Trainees who satisfactorily complete the course requirements and pass the evaluation examination will be given a Certificate in Bridge Teamwork and Resource Management.

Course Intake Limitations:

Master or Chief Officer (team leader), (1) one Second Officer, (1) one Third Officer or (2) two Second Officer or (2) two Third Officer (team members) and (1) one experienced A.B.

Course Duration

Three Days (24 Hours)
